

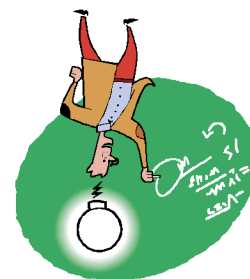


Summarize:

“The important parts are . . .”



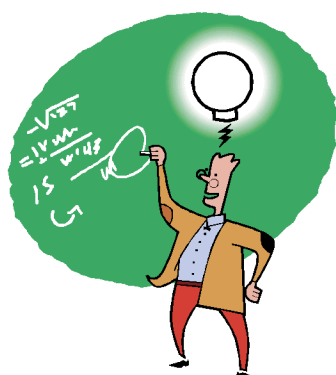
Summarize

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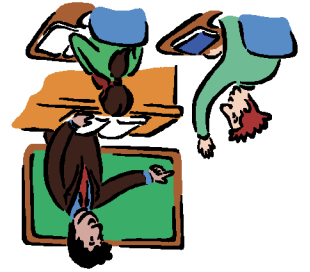
Clarify:

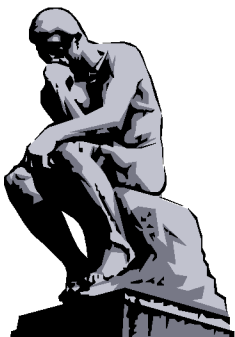
